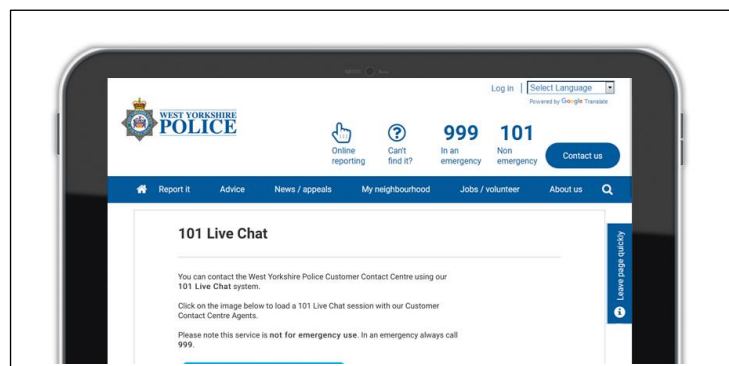
QUESTION & ANSWER SESSION
